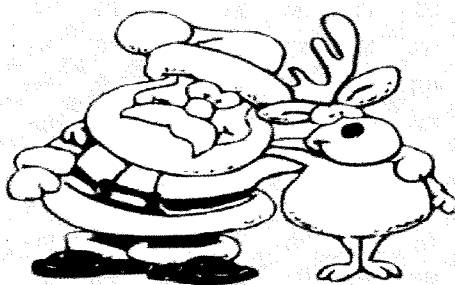


# Meadowmeer G & CC December Newsletter

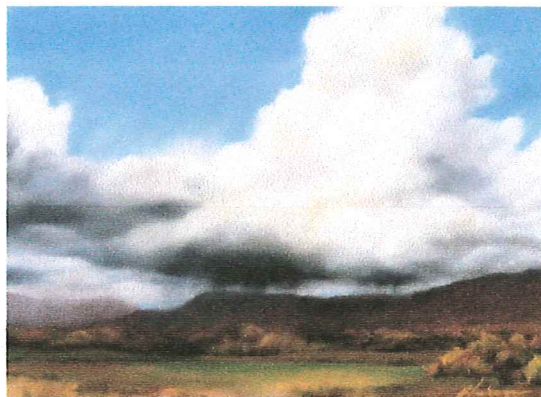

## 2020 Annual Payment Option

**Deadline: December 31, 2019**

Back by popular demand, we're offering another opportunity for you to pre-pay all of 2020's membership dues and receive a one-month discount (December 2020 free). This program worked well for us last year as it provided the needed working capital for the early months of the year.

We would like to offer this program again for 2020. By paying all of 2020 at once, the amount below represents 11 months of dues incorporating the new 2020 cost of living adjusted rates.

You can make this annual payment any time but we have to enforce a deadline that payment must be received no later than 12/31/2020.

\$1021.68 Resident non-golfer annual amount

\$1726.45 Resident golfer annual amount  
(\$1583.90 + sales tax = \$1726.45 Total)

\$1830.51 Non-resident golfer annual amount
