It is always important to play ready golf and keep pace with the group in front of you. The greatest way to show you are a golfer is by displaying proper etiquette. Showing respect for the golf course by repairing ball marks, raking bunkers, and replacing divots are just a few examples. You must also show respect for your fellow golfers.
